## Equal Educational Opportunities Policy

1. Wherever it is practical the school ensures that all learning opportunities, as well as sporting and extra-curricular activities, are so organised as to ensure that *all* children have equal opportunity to participate in all areas.
2. Segregation, for example by gender, except where dictated by necessity, should be avoided; for example, requesting pupils to form separate lines of boys and girls rather than mixed lines.
3. Teaching staff should be aware of, and avoid where at all possible, communicating 'hidden' messages to the pupils; for example, in asking for "four strong boys" to help with a task.
4. Teaching strategies should be planned to include mixed groups of pupils in relation to race, religion, gender and ability.
