Equal Educational Opportunities Policy

- 1. Wherever it is practical the school ensures that all learning opportunities, as well as sporting and extra-curricular activities, are so organised as to ensure that *all* children have equal opportunity to participate in all areas.
- 2. Segregation, for example by gender, except where dictated by necessity, should be avoided; for example, requesting pupils to form separate lines of boys and girls rather than mixed lines.
- 3. Teaching staff should be aware of, and avoid where at all possible, communicating 'hidden' messages to the pupils; for example, in asking for "four strong boys" to help with a task.
- 4. Teaching strategies should be planned to include mixed groups of pupils in relation to race, religion, gender and ability.
